Purple Walk

1 and 1/2 Miles

45 minutes

Mostly flat

Paths are a mixture of tarmac and
compacted trail

Narrow walkways marked with → ←

- To start the purple walk, head around the back of the Museum Shop and Miller's Tearooms and through the gate. The millpond will be on your right.
- The first marker is on the signpost. (see picture)
- Walk straight forward, following the purple mice markers clockwise around the reservoir.



A short walk to take in scenic views close to the historic mill



Follow the mice on the lime green markers



1. Start the lime green walk at the flagpole and head through the cobbled courtyard behind the cottage and through the gates.
2. At the signpost turn right and cross the footbridge over the millpond.
3. Turn left and you'll find the walkway along the reservoir head. Follow the walkway across whilst taking in breath taking views of the Country Park.
4. Turn right at the house at the end and then right again down a steep path with a field on your left.
5. At the bottom go over the two bridges and you'll come out at the playground in the mill yard.
